



Effective spring semester 2009, Alabama State Board of Education policy 801.01, Admissions General, requires that applicants to Alabama Community College System institutions provide one primary form of identification **OR** two secondary forms of identification *prior to admission*.

Prior to being admitted, you must present one *primary* form of identification from the list below:

Unexpired Alabama driver's license or instruction permit	Unexpired U.S. passport
Unexpired Alabama identification card	Unexpired U.S. permanent resident card
Resident Alien Card-Pre1997	U.S. Alien R3registration Receipt Card (Form I-151) prior to 1978
BIA or tribal identification card with photo	Unexpired Driver's License or instruction permit from another state or possession that verifies lawful presence, dated 2000 and beyond

OR

Prior to being admitted, you must present 2 forms of *secondary* identification, 1 of which must include your photograph, from the list below:

U.S. Certificate of Naturalization	BIA or tribal affidavit of birth or certificate of Indian blood
Social Security Card (without restrictions)	USCIS I94 or I94A form
Certified copy of a U.S. Birth Certificate or a U.S. State Department Certificate of Birth Abroad	U.S. Military DD-214
U.S. Certificate of Citizenship	U.S. application for voluntary departure under family unity program (Form I-797)
U.S. Military I.D. (active duty, reserve, retired)	U.S. temporary resident card (Form I-688)
U.S. Armed Forces Driver's License	U.S. notice of approval to apply for permanent residents (Form I-171 or I-463)
U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs Card	Other documentation issued by U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services or presenting status permitted under 8 U.S. Code section 1621 and 1641
Concealed Weapons Permit	Marriage Certificate issued in any U.S. state, territory, or possession
Medical Insurance ID card (except Medicare card or a Mexican Matricula Consulate card)	Employee ID Badge (with photo)
	USCIS employment authorization document (I-688A, I-688B, I-766)
Employee ID (with photo)	U.S. travel document (mint green cover) endorsed with Permit to re-enter (Form I327 or refugee travel document Form I-571)
School ID (with photo)	For documents not listed above or provided in U.S. Code, contact the Department of Postsecondary Education, Instructional and Student Services Division for assistance in determining eligibility.

Primary or secondary forms of identification may be presented in person or through U.S. mail. If you complete your application in person, please present your application to admission staff along with your form(s) of identification to be included with your application.

Primary or secondary forms of identification mailed to the Admissions Office *must* be notarized. **Faxed copies will not be accepted.**
