COURSE DESCRIPTIONS - ANTHROPOLOGY (ANT)

ANT 200 Intro to Anthropology

This course is a survey of physical, social, and cultural development and behavior of human beings. 3 Credit Hours

Psysical Anthropology ANT 210

ANT-200(Intro to Anthropology) with a grade of D or higher or ANT-200(Intro to Anthropology) with a transfer-in grade of C or higher This course is a study of the human evolution based upon fossil and archaeological records as well as analysis of the variation and distribution of contemporary human populations. 3 Credit Hours

ANT 230 Intro to Archaeology

This course is an introduction to archaeological excavation techniques and post-excavation laboratory procedures. 3 Credit Hours
