SUBJECTS AND COURSES

COURSE DESCRIPTIONS - PSYCHOLOGY (PSY)

PSY 200H General Psychology Honors

This course is a survey of behavior with an emphasis on psychological processes. This course includes the biological bases for behavior, thinking, emotion, motivation, and the nature and development of personality. 3 Credit Hours

PSY 200 General Psychology

This course is a survey of behavior with an emphasis on psychological processes. This course includes the biological bases for behavior, thinking, emotion, motivation, and the nature and development of personality. **3 Credit Hours**

PSY 210 Human Growth and Development

PSY-200(General Psychology) with a grade of D or higher or PSY-200(General Psychology) with a transfer-in grade of C or higher This course is a study of the psychological, social and physical factors that affect human behavior from conception to death. 3 Credit Hours

Psychology of Death & Dying

PSY-200(General Psychology) with a grade of C or higher This course is a study of the special psychological adjustments surrounding the issue of death and dealing with the terminally ill. **3 Credit Hours**

PSY 230 Abnormal Psychology

PSY-200(General Psychology) with a grade of C or higher This course is a survey of abnormal behavior and its social and biological origins. The anxiety related disorders, psychoses, personality disorders and mental deficiencies will be covered. 3 Credit Hours

Social Psychology

PSY-200(General Psychology) with a grade of C or higher This course is a study of social factors as they influence individual 3 Credit Hours behavior.

PSY 260 Statistics for the Soc Science

This course is an introduction to the basic statistical concepts, measures, and techniques used in social science research and report writing. It includes both descriptive and inferential statistics. 3 Credit Hours
