COURSE DESCRIPTIONS - SPEECH (SPH)

SPH 106 Fundamentals of Oral Communica

Fundamentals of Oral Communication is a performance course that includes the principles of human communication: intrapersonal, interpersonal, and public. It surveys current communication theory and provides practical application. **3 Credit Hours**

SPH 107 Fund of Public Speaking

This course explores principles of audience and environment analysis as well as the actual planning, rehearsing and presenting of formal speeches to specific audiences. Historical foundations, communication theories and student performances are emphasized. Students prepare and deliver short speeches, practice analytical listening, and engage in various communication exercises. **3 Credit Hours**

SPH 116 Intro Interpersonal Comm

This course is an introduction to the basic principles of interpersonal communication. **3 Credit Hours**
